#### The Influence of the Church on the State: Three Failed Views

#### View #1: Government Should Compel Religion

#### **Response:**

- 1) Jesus refused to force people to believe in Him.
  - > Luke 9:54-56
- 2) True change that will last must begin with the heart of each person.
  - > Jonah 3:5-10
- 3) It exchanges the sovereignty of God with the government, putting secular rulers in an idolatrous and dangerous position.
  - > *Matthew 7:6-11*
- 4) If this practice is applied for Christianity, then it can be applied for other religions as well, depending on who is in office.

#### View #2: Government Should Exclude Religion

- 1) It removes from the government God's teaching about good and evil.
  - > Romans 13:4
- 2) It neglects the real understanding behind the First Amendment & "Separation of Church and State."

"Congress shall make no law respecting the establishment of religion, (ESTABLISHMENT CLAUSE)

or prohibiting the free exercise thereof."

(FREE EXERCISE CLAUSE)

Three Main Interpretations of 1st Amendment and "Separation of Church & State"

- Avoidance
- Acknowledgment
- Accommodation
- 3) <u>It fails to realize that laws are generally based on a moral code rooted in a righteous God,</u> even if that God is not corporately worshipped by those subject to the law.
